"I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing." (1 Tim 2:8)

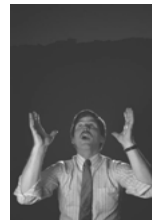
WHY DO WE SING IN TONGUES AND IN ENGLISH?

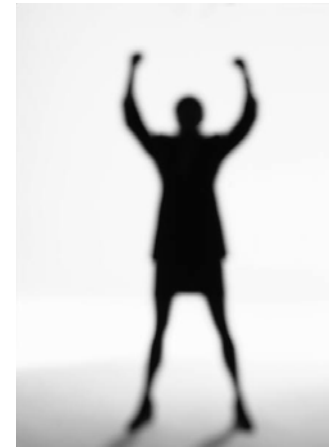
